Scholarships

The very first scholarship in the amount of \$500.00 was awarded to Leah Mason Hauser in May 1996. From May 1996 through May 2010 nineteen (19) ZHS seniors were awarded a \$500.00 scholarship. Since 2011, twenty-seven (27) seniors have received \$27,000 in scholarships.
