Did You Know?

omus was one of the traditions that originated in the second Zanesville High School building. Miss Zella Harris of the class of 1897 visited friends in Toledo. There she saw a school paper. She presented her suggestion for a school magazine to the senior class. Corydon Haddox moved that the class adopt the idea.

Who named the magazine? Many years ago Roy Jordan, Sr., the first business manager of *Comus*, was asked that question. He thought that David Leroy Ferguson selected the name. David, a black boy, was admitted to membership in the St. James Episcopal Church and became a minister. He was located around 1943 in Boston, where he was pastor of a church. Rev. Ferguson could not remember naming Comus. But he did recall that he had written a poem entitled "Comus" for an early number.



At that time and for many years later, a book entitled Milton's Minor Poems was required reading. It contained "Comus, a masque." Comus was the god of revelry. The first issue was published by the senior class in December 1896. Later, Comus became a literary monthly with some news and humor. The art department made cover designs for each issue.

strains of Pomp he and *Circumstance* were just becoming a whisper in our ears. The last footsteps of the last graduate echoed the stage. So went across the commencement exercises for the Zanesville High School Class of 1962. . . And . . .swooosh, fifty years had passed! How could we be old enough to have a 50th reunion? But there it was! And it was a grand reunion!!!!!

How did it come to being? Ron Bucci, traditional coordinator for the reunion, explains that much of the success comes from beginning a compilation of email addresses right around the time of the 45th class reunion and then continually



updating it. The network of nearly 150 classmates became the central hub of getting word out as to when the events of the reunion weekend would be, as well as providing reservation forms and up-dates about responses. Little money needed to be spent for postage and notification was pretty inclusive. However, the committee also poured over lists of graduates to get in touch with others who were not in the email system. Sixteen committee members worked on various aspects of the activities. The reunion itself was set for the first weekend of August 2012 at Bryan's Place in downtown Zanesville, a familiar spot, previously the YWCA. Several people volunteered to decorate the room and Wayne Carpenter, a central figure for many reunions, (and a member of our class) shared ideas he had learned from other groups, so we could benefit from their experiences or generate our own ideas. A large banner featuring all of the Comus senior pictures from our '62 yearbook was created. These images were also copied to be fitted into lanyards, worn to help attendees recognize the new versions of our previous selves. Table favors were planned, musical entertainment hired, and a pleasantly nostalgic Powerpoint was engineered by classmate Lee Gillespie. Several tables would display memorabilia from our era. Door prizes were gathered. (As it turned out, there would be one door prize for each classmate attending.) Pictures were taken throughout the evening by Larry and Sally Morris. The Class of 1962 photo was taken on the steps of Central Presbyterian Church on 6th Street. Local hotels agreed to provide discounts for our out-of-towners. And there were many. In fact folks came from nearly 25 of the 50 states for this big get-together. Many came not just for Saturday evening.

Thursday, some met at Adornetto's Pizzeria for an informal fun time. Friday, 140 got together at Eaglesticks for snacks and drinks. Saturday morning 115 toured the new Zanesville High. Saturday saw many visiting Tom's Ice Cream Bowl or checking out the Y-Bridge Arts Festival, held the same weekend. Finally, it was time for nearly 170 classmates and their guests to celebrate. Our class advisor, Mrs. "B", and several other former teachers were there. We all laughed together and there may have been a tear or two as we shared how life had gone for us as individuals. There was regret from some who had not attended earlier reunions. They had come to realize that rich or poor, fat or thin, from Grover Cleveland, Hancock, or Roosevelt, in sports, music, drama, or not. . .these issues no longer mattered. What did matter is that there is great joy in celebrating our collective endurance and survival. Life can be complex and seems to be fleeting, but this reunion was a wonderful reminder that it is the people, warm memories and shared values that really matter. At the end of the evening revelers could be heard planning other times and places to get together. Old friendships has been rekindled and new appreciations of former acquaintances were in place. Now the music was "Golden Oldies" and our steps were slower as we reluctantly left the building saying, "See you at our 55th."
