ZANESVILLE CITY SCHOOLS HALL OF FAME CLASS of 2013

The sixth class of the Zanesville City Schools will be inducted to the Hall of Fame at a ceremony on Saturday, May 11 at Zanesville High School. The Hall of Fame was established to recognize and perpetuate the names of those men and women who have displayed outstanding ability in or have contributed meritorious service to the prestige and progress of the Zanesville City Schools. Areas recognized may include high school sports, academics, business, fine arts, education and/or other curricular or extra-curricular activities, service to school or community through military service and/or government service, and humanitarian pursuits. The ZCS Hall of Fame committee is pleased to announce the following as 2013 inductees:

Edward Joseph "Joe" Booth, class of 1961, is a lifelong resident of Zanesville and is the second of four sons born to Edmond Booth, a urologist, and Edna Booth, a beautician. Joe served as president of his class, was a member of National Honor Society, and was a varsity letter winner in football, wrestling and track. Graduating with high academic honors from Otterbein College in 1965, he continued his education at the Ohio State University Medical School specializing in Urology. He completed his residency at Cincinnati General Hospital, served for six years in the Air Force National Guard and returned to Zanesville in 1974 where he served the Zanesville community through his private practice for 30 years. Married to Betty



Troyan in 1970, together they had five children, Darin, Kristen, Annie, Elizabeth and Jamie, who all graduated from Zanesville High School. Joe served as team physician for the ZHS track team for six years and coached the Y-City baseball biddy league for four years. President of the Muskingum County Medical Academy and co-founder and first president of the Zanesville Chapter of Ducks Unlimited, Joe also served as Muskingum County Coroner for three years. Joe and his wife Betty continue to live in Zanesville.

Todd David Cerney, class of 1971, was born in Detroit, Michigan. His family moved to Zanesville in 1955.



Studying guitar with Chuck Spires, Todd attended Earlham College where he received his Bachelor of Science degree. He completed his work study semester in Nashville as a recording engineer and returned there in 1977 where he wrote, played and performed as a backup singer. Joining the writing staff of CV Warner-Chappell, he co-wrote and received a Grammy nomination for the song "I'll Still Be Loving You". After working for a time with Sony Corporation, Todd became an independent writer, producer and performer. Over the years he added harmonica, mandolin, keyboard and bass to his instrumental proficiency. In 1984, Todd married Kip Kirby, a writer, editor, TV interviewer and media consultant. In 1988, Todd was with

the group "Music Speaks Louder than Words". He wrote with Russian song writers in Moscow. "Good Morning Beautiful", which he co-wrote, became a number one song that gained him ASCAP awards. Writing with and for many rock groups, Todd expanded the scope of his musical genre and was awarded more gold records. A member of the Nashville Mandolin Ensemble and a lecturer for Writer's Workshops, he toured many foreign embassies, bases, and hospitals with the Nashville Song Writers Band. Developing metastatic malignant melanoma, Todd died in March 2011. As an organ donor, his corneas were harvested so others might see.

Wayne Clark grew up in Frazeysburg where he became very involved in athletics. He began his teaching



and coaching career in 1970 at Licking Valley High School serving as head track and assistant varsity football coach. While in graduate school at Ohio University, he served as graduate assistant in track and field. He began his coaching career in Zanesville in 1976, and became head track coach in 1977 continuing in that position for 22 years. During that time, Wayne revived the men's cross country program and instituted a girls' program and junior high school cross country team. ZHS had 14 athletes win over 30 All-Ohio awards under Wayne's training and guidance. Three won 7 individual State Championships. Wayne also led ZHS teams to over 20 District and League Championships, including Regional Runner-up

and championships in cross country. Wayne was recognized by receiving 19 District or League Coach of the Year Awards. He served as president of the Track Coaches of Ohio and received the Ed Barker Award in 1994, the highest award given by the group. Wayne remains active by being a guest speaker in 19 states and teaching hurdles and sprint relays, leading track camps for athletes in four states, and directing the Ohio High School Clinic. Wayne served in the Viet Nam War where he was a decorated combat infantryman. Residing in Zanesville with his wife Dee Reynolds Clark, Wayne and Dee have two daughters, Lesa and Lori and are proud grandparents of two grandchildren.

Christopher M. Gaiters, Sr., class of 1986, is a homicide sergeant with the Minneapolis Police Department. He is also an adjunct instructor at Saint Mary's University of Minnesota and Hennepin Technical College. While a student at ZHS, Christopher lettered in football, basketball and track and was selected to the All-Ohio high school football team. He represented ZHS at the state high school track and field championships being featured in high hurdles and the high jump. Christopher received a football scholarship to the University of Minnesota where he was Athlete of the Year and third team All-American in football. He also received the Most Valuable Player award from the Chicago Tribune. In 1990, Christopher joined the Minnesota Vikings as wide receiver. In 1991, he entered the



World League of American Football (NFL Europe) draft. He was drafted by the New York/New Jersey Knights and completed the season with the Sacramento Surge. Following his professional football career, Christopher returned to Minneapolis/St. Paul to complete his education. He earned an Associate of Applied Science from Inver Hills Community College, and a Bachelor of Science degree and a Master of Arts degree from Saint Mary's University of Minnesota. Christopher lives in the metro Minneapolis/St. Paul area with his wife and four children.

Dale Henry Mautz, Lash High School class of 1942, has enjoyed serving and supporting Zanesville High



School Athletic programs for over 60 years. Born in Zanesville in1924, Dale attended Munson Elementary and Roosevelt Junior High before graduating from high school. He worked as a mould maker at Zanesville Mould Company for 44 years. Married to Juanita Bailey in 1946, Dale and his wife raised four children who were all involved in various Blue Devil activities. In the early 1950's, Dale joined the Zanesville High School Athletic Boosters and served as secretary in 1961 and president in 1985. He has planned sports banquets, organized basketball previews and sold programs at football and basketball games. He worked on the chain gang at home football games from 1967-2005 and for 20 years assisted with the

scoreboard during boys' and girls' basketball games. Helping with many chicken barbecue fundraisers for the Athletic Boosters, Dale has been seen setting up and tearing down the pits, hauling bags of charcoal, cooking the barbecue sauce, turning racks and serving chicken dinners. His dedication to ZHS is not only with athletics, but he helped his wife start the band boosters waffle stand for which he designed the first

stainless steel tanks for frying the waffles. Dale spent many hours helping Wayne Carpenter create, build and paint numerous props for the Devilettes and designed the pole assembly for a 30 foot American flag raised in St. John's Arena at OSU during the 1975 Ohio State Drill Team Championship where the Devilettes were named State Champions. In 1985 and 1989, Dale received Appreciation Awards for his outstanding service and dedication to Zanesville Blue Devil Athletics. He was recognized by the Ohio High School Athletic Association for his exemplary contribution and service and in 2009 was the recipient of the "Respect the Game" award.

Dr. John Miller, class of 1959, is chairman of the Miller Group and Emeritus Professor of Communication Studies at the Kent State University. Dr. Miller was also professor at the University of Southern Mississippi and the People's University of China. Dr. Miller has a B.A. from Western Kentucky University and a M.A. and Doctorate in Organizational Communication from the University of Southern Mississippi. He has co-authored the books <u>Speak Up for Business</u>, <u>Managing Your Communication</u>: <u>In and For the Organization</u>, and <u>Working for the Best: Can Jump Start America</u>. He is one of only 300 speakers worldwide to receive the "Certified Speaking Professional" designation from the 3000 member National Speakers Association. Dr. Miller has lectured in all fifty states and



in Brazil, China, Japan, India and the former Soviet Union and Western Europe. Dr. Miller's former students include Olympic champions, Major League baseball players, 25 members of the National Football League and network television personalities. Dr. Miller speaks and conducts team-building management motivation programs for many professional association and Fortune 500 companies including IBM, GE, AT&T, AEP, GM, Exxon, General Dynamics, Rockwell International, Lockhead and more.

James K. Robinson, class of 1960, played basketball while at ZHS and was leading scorer in his senior



year. Jim was named to the All Central Ohio League first team and to the Central Ohio League All-Opponent first team. He continued his basketball career at Mount Union College for four years, being coached by Wayne Ashbaugh who had previously guided the ZHS basketball team to the 1955 State Championship. Obtaining a B.A. in Secondary Education from Mount Union, Jim earned a Masters Degree in School Administration at Xavier University and completed post-graduate work at Fredonia State University and Xavier University. He began his career teaching social studies and coaching varsity basketball at Lake Shore Central High School in Angola, New York. In 1966, he returned to Zanesville and taught one year at Roosevelt Junior High and five years at ZHS. He was a member of the basketball and cross country coaching staffs.

Jim became principal at Maysville Junior High School in 1972 and spent 30 years in school administration serving as assistant superintendent of the Maysville Local Schools, principal at Roosevelt Junior High School and assistant superintendent of the Zanesville City Schools. In 1985, Jim became superintendent of the Zanesville City schools serving for eleven years. After his retirement in 1996, Jim spent seven years as a program administrator for the Muskingum County Board of Developmental Disabilities. Under Jim's leadership as superintendent, the Zanesville community passed three levies in 1985, 1989 and 1994. District programs received statewide recognition from the Ohio Department of Education, the Ohio School Boards Association and the inaugural Ohio's BEST Practices Program during his tenure. Jim's wife Judy taught English at ZHS for 32 years. Their children Michael, Beth and Matthew all graduated from Zanesville High School.
