The Zanesville Alumni Association is very proud to announce that three of our members have received this designation.



#### Dan Hennessey

Dan Hennessey has contributed so much to Zanesville and Muskingum County over his lifetime. Dan started as a Boy Scout and became an Eagle Scout and received the God and Country Merit. He was inducted to the Hall of Honor of the Ohio Trucking Association and the Emeritus Board of Goodwill Industries and is Past Chairman of both. Dan is a member of the Zanesville Rotary Club, Zanesville Chamber of Commerce, Ohio Chamber of Commerce, and the Zanesville Quarterback Club. He has also served as chairman of the Muskingum County American Heart Association. Dan was recognized as a

2009 Muskingum County Hero.

#### Liz Burrier

Although retired from teaching, her passion for students and learning continues to burn bright. With her husband Jim Burrier, Liz was one of the founding members of the West Muskingum Academic Fund established in 1982. For 30 years, the fund continues to operate as a nonprofit foundation. The interest earned from the principle is spent each year to support enrichment opportunities for West M students. To date, the Academic Fund has provided nearly \$200,000 in financial support and has touched the lives of nearly 100,000 West Muskingum students. Her ties remain close with the Zanesville City Schools, another venue for her tireless commitment to education. She is a founding member of the Zanesville City Schools Hall of Fame. She played a vital role in assisting Wayne Carpenter with the event



highlighting the closure of the fourth Zanesville High School. She is a member of the Zanesville Quarterback Club and Zanesville Tip Off Club. She may have left the classroom, but she is engaged and committed to education in so many ways. Liz was recognized as a 2010 Muskingum County Hero.





Betty totally exemplifies what a true hero is. When Betty does a job, she gives her heart and soul, or she doesn't do it. Betty volunteered for 14 years at The Wilds and she has been a volunteer at Genesis Healthcare for 20 years and is still active. She has volunteered her time to the Zanesville High School Alumni Association since 1994, helping with the history of ZHS. Betty came to Jeff Dittmar asking for help with the final solicitation of funds for the WWII/Korean Memorial. They still needed over \$48,000 to complete the job. Betty gave her time and resources working on a daily basis in order to get the project done. Not only did they raise enough money to get the job done, they had money left over to purchase medals

for each WWII/Korean Veteran. Betty is also a member of the ZHS Class of 1949 and is always involved in organizing a breakfast and class reunions. Every year her class has a float in the Veteran's Day Parade that Betty and her husband both organized. Betty is a board member of the Muskingum County Senior Center. Betty was recognized as the 2011 Senior Adult Hero.
