Dedication of Trees - Second Phase

The second phase of trees purchased by graduating classes is nearing completion. At the time of printing of this newsletter, the date for the dedication was not set but watch on the Zanesville City Schools website Alumni link for details as they become available. In July of 2012, fifteen trees were dedicated in the courtyard at the high school. Years represented were 1951, 1956, 1959, 1960, 1961, 1962, 1964, 1965, 1966, 1967, 1971, 1974, 1976, 1981 and the Devilettes 1966-2011. At this time, eight of the nine trees running parallel to the front of the school have been purchased by the classes of 1949, 1952, 1953, 1963, 1957, 1968, 1969, and 1972.

Classes having reunions this year are being provided information that may lead to their purchase of a tree. However, ANY class is invited and encouraged to purchase a tree at the cost of \$400. Plaques with your class year are placed at the base of a tree to be

viewed by all who attend the many activities at ZHS as well as students attending school. Much of the proceeds go to the Scholarship Fund that provides scholarships for graduating seniors every year.



Any graduates in the history of Zanesville High School attained prominence in the state and in the nation. Ralph Mershon, a former Zanesville High School student, thought his English textbook contained errors. He dropped out, tutored with Superintendent Lash and went to Ohio State University. After graduating with the first class in electrical engineering in 1890, he became world famous in his profession. He willed eleven million dollars to O.S.U., one-half the income to be used for military training and one-half for general use, but not one cent for intercollegiate athletics. A large auditorium on the university campus still bears his name.
