# Our History

anesville High School graduate Jennifer Huffman Stewart (Class of 1968) presented the idea of an alumni organization to the Zanesville Board of Education in September 1994. With the ZCS Board's support, the organizational meeting of the Zanesville Alumni Association (ZAA), with numerous alumni in attendance, was held October 19, 1994.

Several fundraisers have been held over the years to provide scholarships to ZHS seniors. Currently, we sell Alumni Discount Cards, host an alumni dinner before ZHS Homecoming, and offer the opportunity for classes to purchase an Alumni Tree at ZHS. Scholarships have been awarded to graduating seniors every year since 1996. In 2016 five seniors will receive a \$1,000.00 scholarship.

The Alumni Association is a 501 (c)(3) organization. This means that any donation made to ZAA is tax deductible. ZAA is operated by a seven (7) member Board of Trustees elected by the membership.

# Alumní Center

n 2016, the ZAA opened a center in the Board of Education Administrative Center at 956 Moxahala Avenue in Zanesville. Many artifacts dating back to the 1800s are on display. Our yearbook (Comus) collection which started as a monthly publication in the 1800s, the Zanesvillians which were published weekly in the Zanesville newspapers, pictures, and documents are preserved in the center. Vintage ZHS uniforms, and various sweaters and jackets can also be found in the center. A variety of DVDs including of the Hall of Fame inductions, the demolition of the fourth ZHS, the 1995 State Championship basketball game can be viewed on the 50 inch screen in the center.

The Alumni Association displays and stores all donated items to help keep the Zanesville High School legacy alive for all past, present and future Blue Devils.

Donations of historical documents are welcomed as well as volunteers to help the Association organize and catalog documents.

Currently the center is open to the public on Thursdays from 10:00 AM till 4:00 PM. We are also open by appointment for people or groups that cannot come in on Thursdays.
